- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:30
- 2. Review of November 14 meeting minutes
  - a. S Fogelson had a correction. Meagen Kerris was not at the 11/14 meeting. Deletion was made and a motion to approve the minutes as amended was made and seconded.
  - b. Minutes of November 14, 2023, approved as revised.
- 3. The **Library** proposed budget was reviewed. Representing the Library Trustee's were Betsy Holmes, Eric Stauffer and Susan Thomas.
  - a. Their proposed budget was presented as slightly down from 2023 Budget.
  - b. They presented a Warrant article requesting that the full value in the Deering Library Expendable Trust fund be transferred into the Library Building Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund. This is roughly \$5,500 \$6,000.
  - c. They shared a list of maintenance type items including repair of windows, repair/replace the lock set, interior painting, shelving, building sign.
  - d. Discussion on maintenance items and funding pursued.
- 4. BAC recommendations for the Library Budget.
  - a. Recommend adding \$400 to line 249 Library Building Maintenance.
  - b. Recommend submitting warrant article as presented.

- 5. The **Cemetery** proposed budget was reviewed. Representing the Cemetery Trustee's were Kay Hartnett, John Reynolds and Kristi LeGore
  - a. Their proposed budget was presented with an increase of \$4,600 21.4% over 2023 budget.
  - b. There is a request for funds for many maintenance type projects including tree removal, stump grinding, iron works, stone repair and maintenance.
- 6. The BAC recommendations for the **Cemetery** Budget include:
  - a. Recommend line 108 to read \$500 thus cutting \$3,000.
  - b. Recommend line 109 to read \$17,600 thus cutting \$4,400.
  - c. No change in line 110 \$600
  - d. Resulting in an overall 2024 Budget of \$18,700
  - e. Recommend that monies cut above for maintenance type items tree cutting, iron work, stump grinding, fixing of stones etc. be taken from the Trust Fund Balance.
