

Town of Deering Website Use Policy

The Town of Deering Website Use Policy describes the standards and guidelines by which the Town manages information on this website. The Town has established this website for the primary purpose of providing information to the public regarding services available to the public from Town government, as well information regarding services available to the public from other governmental agencies and private organizations in partnership with the Town.

This Website Use Policy is effective as of Nov 1, 2004, concurrent with the establishment of the Town's updated website. The Town expects to update the website and this Website Use Policy on a regular basis in order to incorporate improvements over time. As updates to this policy are adopted, the Town Clerk in accordance with the Town's records retention policy will maintain archived versions of older policies.

Link Policy (Town Links to External Websites)

The purpose of this policy is to identify the criteria and conditions by which the Town provides links to external websites. The Town's primary purpose for linking to external websites is for the Town to provide information to the public regarding services available to the public from other governmental agencies and private organizations in partnership with the Town. Thus, the Town is not establishing a forum for others to provide information. Rather, the Town is providing information to direct website users to resources outside the Town which provide services to the general public which are complementary to and in support of the services provided by the Town.

Event Calendar Policy

The Town of Deering provides a listing of events in Deering as a service to its customers. This list is not an exhaustive list of all events in Deering. The Town may list events that meet one of the following criteria:

- Town events (e.g. Board and Commission meetings)
- Events the Town sponsors
- Relevant meetings of any non-Town government agency
- Events open to the general public for which the Town approves a special events permit and/or approves the use of public rights-of-way or Town property
