Description of matters discussed and final decisions made:

The board discussed the hiring of three new Fire Department employees (D. Russel, M. Berry, and M. Klumb). They reviewed the applications and the need of the department to accept these employees. J. Leblanc explained that the Fire Department is currently following a payment plan for EMT's, On-Call and Part-Time employees. He noted he would like to offer Berry 17.00hr, Klumb \$13, and Russell's would be \$9 dependent on a review of the payment plan. The Board agreed that these applicants would fill the missing employee seats and that they would make a motion to accept them in public session.

The second topic of discussion was the newly hired Administrative assistants' benefits. The board discussed the benefits within the employee handbook and noted that after the 6-month probationary period they would review her benefits.

Note: Under RSA 91-A:3, III. Minutes of proceedings in nonpublic sessions shall be kept and the record of all actions shall be promptly made available for public inspection, except as provided in this section. Minutes and decisions reached in nonpublic session shall be publicly disclosed within 72 hours of the meeting, unless, by recorded vote of 2/3 of the members present, it is determined that divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of this board, or render the proposed action of the board ineffective, or pertain to terrorism. In the event of such circumstances, information may be withheld until, in the opinion of a majority of members, the aforesaid circumstances no longer apply.
