Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 June to 30 June 2011. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 26 calls during the month.

The Town Highway Mechanic performed repairs to one of the warning lights on Ambulance One. Another light was reported out on Tanker One, we are waiting for that part to arrive. W.D. Perkins Inc. also adjusted the pump packing on Tanker One.

Engine Three returned from its trip for refurbishment that began in March and was officially put back in service on June 30th.

The restrooms at the Donovan Station are back in service.

Captain Daryl Mundy has requested and been granted a ninety day Personal Leave of Absence retroactive to June 1st.

I was accompanied by Assistant Chief Chris Ladue and Deputy Chief Jim Tramontozzi to conduct a Foster Home Inspection at 753 Deering Center Road on June 14th.

EMS Training on the 21st consisted of a presentation regarding Diving Emergencies. This was delivered by Firefighter/EMT Tony Mayfield, an active Diver who is working on becoming a Dive Instructor.

Fire Training was held on June 28th with members becoming aware of the capabilities of our newly purchased Thermal Imaging Camera. The TIC is in service on Engine One.

On June 2nd Firefighters Chrissy Elliott and Shawn Stone along with six of our Explorers (Cole & Logan Bannister, Austin & Ty Brown, Daina Tramontozzi and Steven Whitney) attended Career Day at the Hillsboro Deering Middle School providing demonstrations with Tanker One. Three of the Explorers, Austin and Ty Brown and Justin Dion, also toured the New Hampshire Fire Academy on June 28th during Explorer Week.
