All of our apparatus is in service.

Tony Mayfield has joined the Department and has been assigned to the Donovan Station. Firefighter Kris Saunders has successfully completed his Certified Career Firefighter exam.

Fire Prevention night was held on October 6th at the Donovan Station and was well attended by fifty children and their parents. Our annual Awards Ceremony scheduled for October 13th was postponed.

We participated in a Mutual Aid Drill at the Hillsboro-Deering High School on October 26th for our monthly training. Our members conducted Search and Rescue, Ventilation, and EMS support for patients "injured" at a mock explosion in the Chemistry Lab.

Two Boston area comedians made the trip to the American Legion in Hillsboro to help us raise money for a Thermal Imaging Camera.
