Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 December to 31 December 2010. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 11 calls during the month, ending the year with a total of 230.

All of our apparatus is in service.

The new furnace was installed at the Murdough Station on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. The following week repairs were made to the weather stripping of the overhead door (Engine Three bay). Both overhead doors were serviced during the same visit.

We continue to work with the State Fire Marshal's Office and the Superintendant of the Hillsboro-Deering Schools to find housing for the students displaced by the closing of the Alternative High School program.

EMS Training was not scheduled during the month of December. On the 28<sup>th</sup> half of the Department participated in the annual Blood Borne Pathogens training. This program is mandatory, so those who missed this session will need to complete the training in January.

To check on good girls and boys of all ages in Deering, Engine One delivered Santa Claus (and some Helpers) to the Town Hall on the 11<sup>th</sup> for the Town's annual Christmas festivities. After that, Mr. Claus requested a quick ride to His Mansion, Longwood's and Johnson Parks, and Robin Hill Farm. We are honored to continue this Holiday Tradition.
