Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 September to 30 September 2011. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 23 calls during the month, including a Structure Fire on East Deering Road.

Ambulance One was briefly out of service with transmission problems that were diagnosed and then later repaired by Hillsboro Ford with assistance from the Highway Department Mechanic. We had been experiencing problems with the onboard generator on Engine Three since that apparatus returned from being refurbished. (The unit had been disconnected and removed from the Engine when it went out for service.) Firefighter John Pearl has repaired the generator and it is now in service.

It appears that all Deering Fire & Rescue apparatus has been through State Inspection.

We have experienced no further leaks from the roof of the Donovan Station and believe that the existing shingles will hold out until they can be replaced in the Spring of 2012.

Firefighter Ed Whitney began his FFI class at the Hillsboro Fire Station on September 7<sup>th</sup>.

EMS Training took place on the 20<sup>th</sup> with a review of our new cardiac monitor. Fire Training consisted of water supply and hose line advances and was held at the McAlister Station on the 27<sup>th</sup>.

Our annual Family BBQ – which was washed out by Hurricane Irene in August – took place on the 18<sup>th</sup> at Oxbow Campground.

The Fire and Rescue Call Summary, Ambulance Call Summary, and Apparatus Report for the month of September are attached.
