

MONTHLY REPORT**JULY 2012****NEWS:**

1. Expedition is back in service. It "hit 100K" miles shortly thereafter. Ofc. Migdal is apparently too young to know what "push it a mile" referred to and all he did was take a picture of it!
2. Chief Pushee and the Police Cadets spent a long weekend at their booth at Balloon Fest, including fundraising efforts through the Dunk Tank and water sales.
3. Chief Pushee and the Police Cadets helped out with the Special Olympics fundraising event at Irving Gas Station in Hillsboro during the Irving/SONH "Protect and Service" day.
4. Chief Pushee spent two days helping teach recruit officers at the FT Police Academy in Concord.
5. The PD is in the process of scheduling another student intern for Fall Semester, one of our former Cadets, who is now a Sophomore at NHTI in Concord.

TRAINING:

1. Chief Pushee recertified as a OC Pepper Spray Instructor at the Police Academy.
2. Department conducted Firearms Training at the range (primarily rifle tactics).
3. Ofc. Migdal and Ofc. Collins were trained in Emergency Vehicle Operations by the Stevens Driving School, courtesy of the Local Govt Center.

GRANTS:

1. Highway Safety Agency Grants: OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE: This grant program continues, and assigns for one day each month an extra cruiser on the road for safe driver & enforcement patrols during specific "commuter" hours. Chief Pushee prepared and sent quarterly activity reports to the NH Highway Safety Agency on this grant.
2. 1033 Defense Reutilization Program: nothing recently on this grant.
3. Highway Safety Agency "Speed" Grant 2012: We will be completing this grant program by the end of August, and will then compile statistics and make request for reimbursement.
4. Highway Safety Agency "Local DWI" Grant 2012: We continue working these 5 hour overtime patrol grants, which will end in mid-September. I have been preparing and sending quarterly activity reports to the NH Highway Safety Agency on this grant.
5. NH Fish & Game "Wheeled OHRV Enforcement Grant 2011-2012" –Chief Pushee has sent in the reimbursement request and final reports on this program.

JUVENILE ACTIVITY:

1. We have a Criminal Mischief/Vandalism case involving 4 Juveniles. We intend to sent this through diversion, though have been unable to make contact with our Diversion Coordinator. She may be on vacation or otherwise unavailable, so we are also looking into Merrimack County Diversion.
2. While not Juvenile Activity, we are sponsoring the FAST Program in Deering for about 18 members of the infamous GHS Party Case.

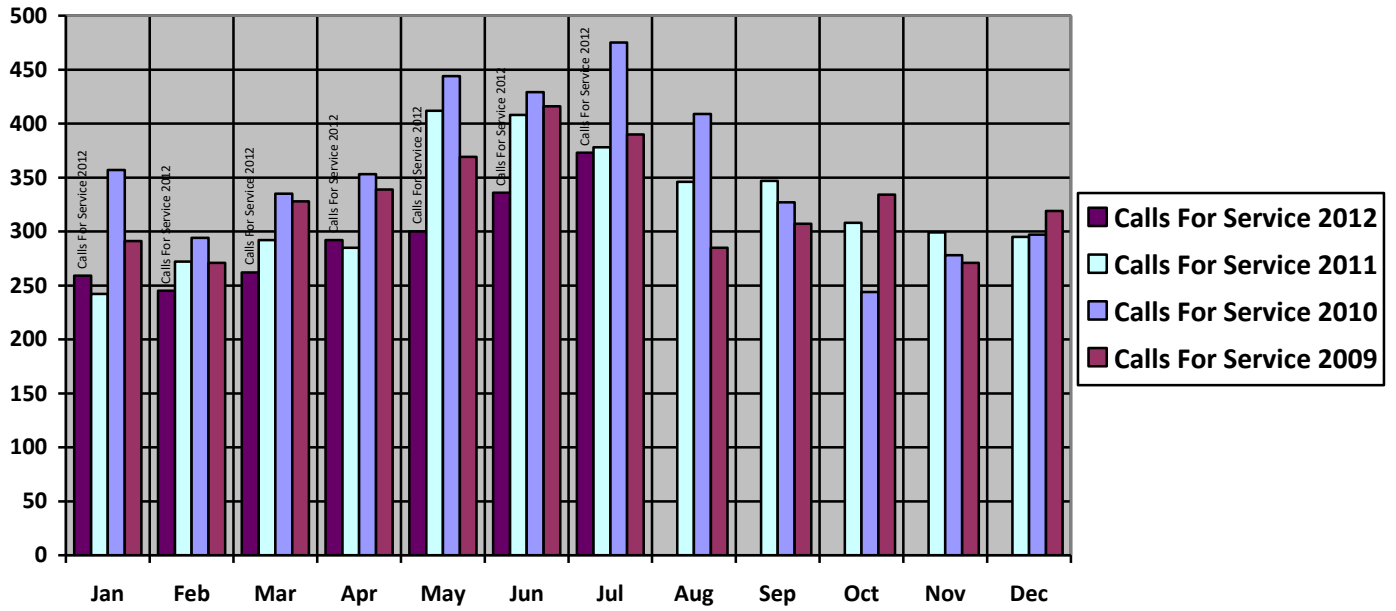
