1. We have no Juvenile Diversion Referrals or Court Actions in December 2015.

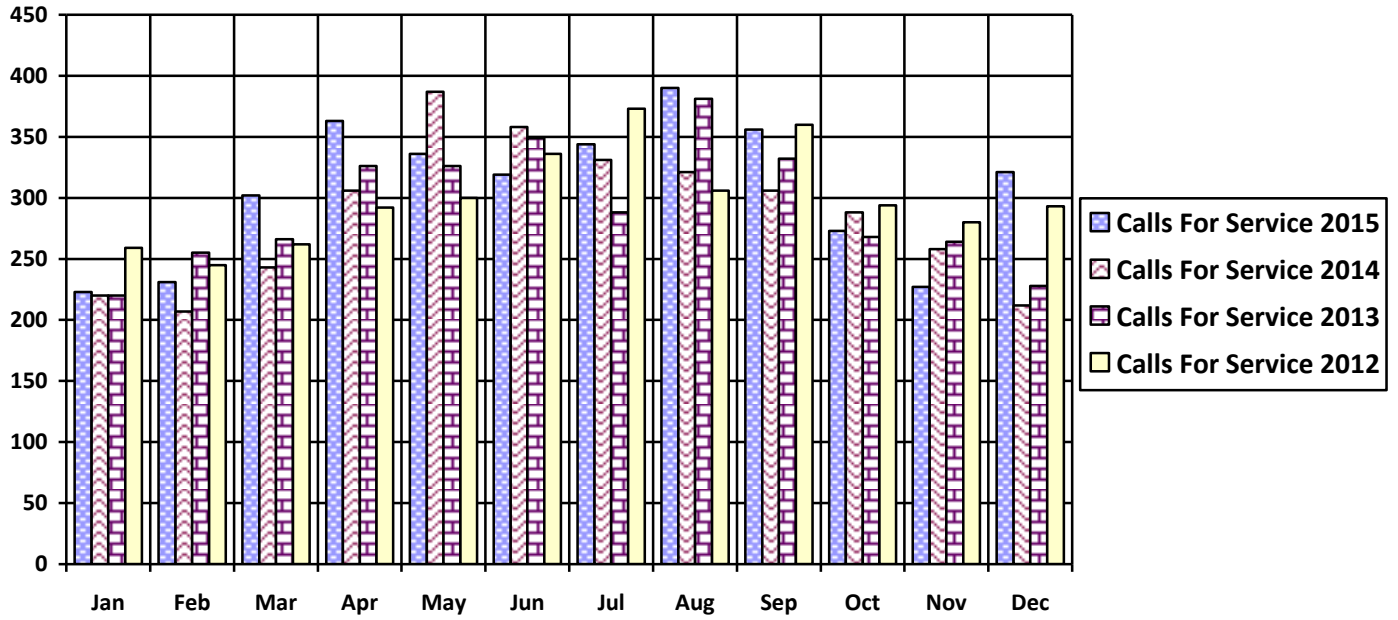
