NEWS:

TRAINING:

GRANTS:

- 1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE 2014-2015: We continue working these patrols once a month.
 - b. SPEED ENFORCEMENT: We have begun working these patrols, and Chief Pushee submitted quarterly reports and reimbursement requests
 - c. DWI ENFORCEMENT: We have begun working these patrols, and Chief Pushee submitted quarterly reports and reimbursement requests
 - d. TRAFFIC SIGN/SIGNALS: We have begun working these patrols, and Chief Pushee submitted quarterly reports and reimbursement requests
- 2. TIRE DEFLATION DEVICES: We have received these stop sticks. Chief Pushee will be submitted the invoice for payment, and once the check is cashed by StopStick LTD, we can submit for reimbursement of half the cost. We plan to conduct training classes in these prior to placing them into service.
- 3. Highway Safety Agency Grant Programs are being "restructured" and it doesn't appear Deering will be eligible to apply for patrol grants for next budget year. Chief Pushee will be attended a meeting on July 16th in Concord, though it appears the decisions have already been made about this issue.


