NEWS:

- 1. Internships: We continue to sponsor two High School Interns.
- 2. Ofc. Migdal out on short term disability due to off duty injury.
- 3. 2010 Chevy Impala was hit by another motorist while on patrol, sustaining moderate damage to rear body panels and suspension components. NH State Police was assigned the crash investigation.
- 4. We had one citizen firearm related injury in Deering during the month (accidental).
- 5. Both cruisers inspected for the year. 2003 Expedition needed frame welding to pass.

TRAINING:

- 1. There was no in-house PD Training this month due to scheduling difficulties. We are trying to schedule two training sessions in April.
- 2. Cpl. Nick Hodgen attended a two week "Supervisors" Course at NH-PSTC.
- 3. Capt. Thomas Cavanaugh attended a Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus/Standard Field Sobriety Testing Refresher Class.

GRANTS:

- 1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE: This grant program is being worked. Special Traffic Safety Patrols during Morning and Afternoon Commute hours. Chief Pushee will be submitting quarterly reports and reimbursement soon.
 - b. SPEED Patrol Grant: This grant program for 90 hours of Speeding-Directed Enforcement Patrols has been approved, and final paperwork should be received shortly. This will provide 30-three hour special patrols dedicated to speed enforcement on state roadways.
 - c. DWI Patrol Grant: This grant program for 90 hours of DWI –Directed Enforcement Patrols has been approved, and final paperwork should be received shortly. This will provide 18-five hour special patrols on Friday/Saturday/Holiday late nights, dedicated to DWI Enforcement efforts.
 - d. VIDEO Grant: Chief Pushee has submitted a grant application for a matching grant to help fund the purchase of a new Cruiser Video System for the new SUV Cruiser that is on order. Still going over options for particular video units before deciding what brand/model to choose.
- 2. Portable Radio Grant #2 We are awaiting a schedule for an appointment to get our newest portable radio programmed.
- 3. Fish & Game Agency- OHRV Enforcement Grant: I have submitted an application for up to 15-five hour OHRV specific directed enforcement patrols, but history of this grant indicates that this may well be cut by about 1/3 of the requested amount, if approved.


