NEWS:

- 1. Cruiser Maintenance: We had the equipment tech come in and replace a faulty circuit board in the light bar of the 2014 cruiser. He also made some adjustments to some of our settings, and installed/moved a couple spare lights (for better side visibility) in the 2013 and 2014 cruisers.
- 2. Officer Vaillancourt continues in Field Training. He has received the majority of his schedule for the "law package" classes, and should have most of those completed by early March.
- 3. Members of the Cadet Post helped with Traffic and Parking Control for the Annual Town Children's Christmas Party.

TRAINING:

1. Chief Pushee, Officer Vaillancourt, Cadet Advisor Hargreaves, and Assistant Cadet Advisor DeOrio all went through an on-line training in Youth Protection Policies for the Boy Scouts/Exploring program.

GRANTS:

- 1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE 2014-2015: We are working this grant one day each month, as assigned by the NH Highway Safety Agency. This grant provides an officer specifically for traffic safety enforcement efforts during the commuter hours.
 - SPEED ENFORCEMENT: We have received preliminary approvals for this grant, totaling 90 hours of Speed Enforcement efforts, totaling over \$5500. Final approvals should come in a week or two.
 - c. DWI ENFORCEMENT: We have received preliminary approvals for this grant, totaling 120 hours of DWI Enforcement efforts, totaling over \$7500. Final approvals should come in a week or two.
 - d. TRAFFIC SIGN/SIGNALS: We have received preliminary approvals for this grant, totaling 36 hours of Traffic Sign/Signal Enforcement efforts, totaling over \$2500. Final approvals should come in a week or two.


