Sept 1st to Sept 29th, 2014

NEWS:

- 1. 2013 Ford Interceptor Utility door skins have been repaired under warranty. They recommend mud flaps to help dissuade dirt from getting into the problem door channel, and they put spray on bedliner type material to ward off future issues. May need to do similar to the 2014 Cruiser before it rusts in the same manner.
- 2. Cadets provided Food Service for Regional Police/Search & Rescue K9 Competition held in Hillsborough.
- Cadets went to Antrim to help with traffic control for the Home & Harvest Parade, and then went back the next evening to help with parking and traffic control for the Town BBQ Dinner and Fireworks.
- 4. Officer Bennett has completed his Full Time employment, but upon an agreement has been retained as a Part Time Officer, though he will not be available to work any shifts in Deering until he completes his Hillsboro PD Field Training.
- 5. Public Safety Day is this weekend, October 4th, 2014, from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM!!
- 6. We have conducted Physical Agility Test and have several candidates that need to go through the interview process.

TRAINING:

- 1. Due to schedule issues and a late announced state training session, departmental training was postponed to September
- 2. Chief Pushee & Ofc. Philibert (in his capacity for Hillsboro PD) attended "VALOR" training in Concord. This is a free training on Officer Safety trends and issues sponsored by the US Dept of Justice, NESPIN, the NH Police Academy, and the Portsmouth PD. There were session on Domestic Terrorist threats, Active Shooter response, identifying hidden weapons, and Medical "Self-Aid" during shooting events, including training on tourniquet use.

GRANTS:

- 1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE 2013-2014: We completed this grant program and submitted for re-imbursement for \$794 for this final quarter.
 - b. SPEED Patrol Grant: We completed this grant program and submitted for reimbursement for \$1979 for this final quarter.
 - DWI Patrol Grant: We completed this grant program and submitted for reimbursement for \$1593 for this final quarter.
 - d. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE 2014-2015: We received final approvals for this grant program. This will provide 2 three hour shifts during commute hours on a certain day each month. We have been approved for nearly \$5K in reimbursements for this grant with overtime & personnel costs.


