Interim Road Agent Brett Martin discussed an employee concern with the Board.

Interim Road Agent Martin presented an employment application from Marty Fisher, discussed his qualifications, and recommended a starting pay of \$25.50/hr with the possibility of an additional increase after a satisfactory six-month probationary period review. After Board discussion, Chair Smith moved to extend an offer of employment to Marty Fisher for a full-time position as an Equipment Operator at the rate of \$25.50/hr, contingent upon confirmation that he has a valid CDL license and contingent upon passing all other standard HR hiring requirements. Seconded by Selectman Watson. Motion passed 3-0. This action and vote will be announced in public session to follow.

Interim Road Agent Martin discussed the wage rate for employee Darin Labier with relation to his tenure and work performance and recommended an increase to \$28/hr. After Board discussion, Chair Smith moved to increase the wage rate for employee Darin Labier from \$26.46/hr to \$28/hr. Seconded by Selectman Watson. Motion passed 3-0. This action and vote will be announced in public session to follow.
