Description of matters discussed and final decisions made:

The board reviewed an offer of employment for the book keeper position. J. Peel noted that with the previous book keeper giving her resignation letter in early October a replacement needed to be ready before the end of the year so that the community could prepare for the audit. J. Peel explained that he had looked into other options like MRI and Tyler Technologies for support, but found this one would be the most cost effective.
