Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 April to 30 April 2012. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 18 calls during the month, including Mutual Aid responses to five building fires in seven days.

The Town Highway Mechanic repaired the panel lights on Engine Three. All of our apparatus is in service.

Work continued at the Donovan Station converting one of the bathrooms to a storage room.

Fire and EMS training took place on the 17<sup>th</sup> with Concord Fire Department Paramedic Tony Manning delivering a presentation on Fireground Rehab.

We participated in joint Fire Training with the Hillsboro Fire Department on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The topic for the month consisted of Ladder carries, raises and victim rescue. The drill was conducted at the Hillsboro-Deering High School and was well attended by members of both Departments.

Seven of our members are taking one of the first Emergency Medical Responder classes to be offered in the State. This certification replaces what was formerly called First Responder. The class is being delivered by Great Brook Safety Academy and we are hosting the program along with the Henniker Fire Department. Evening classes take place in Henniker on Tuesdays and Deering on Thursdays.
