Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 February to 29 February 2012. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 15 calls during the month.

All of our apparatus is in service.

The turnout gear washer and dryer are in service at the Donovan Station. We have been cleaning the old PPE that is still serviceable; the Explorers have inherited some of the gear while others have been placed in storage. We are in the process of disposing of all turnout gear that is not compliant.

EMS training for the month was held on the 21st. Concord Paramedic Tony Manning gave us a presentation on the use of Intraosseous Infusion. This Advanced Life Support tool increases our capability to deliver medication to our patients.

The short month combined with a busy work schedule for our Training Officer forced us to postpone Fire Training for the month of February. An additional training date has been scheduled for March.
