Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 January to 31 January 2011. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 22 calls during the month.

Engine Two's brakes required adjustment by the Town Highway Mechanic. Tanker One is still in service but will need repairs to three valves.

On the 21<sup>st</sup>, Assistant Chief Ladue and I were present when the State Fire Marshal conducted an inspection of the Alternative High School housed at the Airport on 2<sup>nd</sup> New Hampshire Turnpike. While there are still some "house-keeping" items to complete, the building was approved by the Fire Marshal for the students to return to the building. We will continue to work with all parties involved to assure that everything remains in compliance for the rest of this year and for each annual inspection.

EMS Training was held on the 25<sup>th</sup>, consisting of a review of our equipment and where it is located in the Ambulance. Fire Training took place on the 23<sup>rd</sup> with Lt. Scott Carrigan of the Nashua Fire Department visiting us to present the Courage To Be Safe program offered through the National Fallen Firefighter's Foundation.

On the 4<sup>th</sup>, several more of our members received the Blood Borne Pathogens training they had missed in December. At this time approximately two-thirds of the members have received this mandatory program.

The Fire and Rescue Call Summary, Ambulance Call Summary, and Apparatus Report for the month of December are attached.
