Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 July to 31 July 2012. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 14 calls during the month.

Tanker One experienced problems drafting at a Mutual Aid Building Fire in Weare on the 23rd. When the pump maintenance mechanics came to the station, they were unable to recreate the failure so we will keep an eye on this issue to see if it occurs again. Earlier in the month, the packing on the pump for Tanker One required adjusting; the two issues were unrelated.

All of our other apparatus is in service.

The bathroom to storage room conversion at the Donovan Station has been completed.

EMS training took place on the 17<sup>th</sup> with Lieutenant Gidley providing a refresher on the use of our Auto Pulse unit.

Fire training was held on the 31<sup>st</sup> with Captain Joe Bulcock conducting pump training at Deering Lake.

Engine Two traveled to Greenville for their annual Fourth of July Pots & Pans parade and came home with a trophy for Furthest Traveled.

We assisted the Hillsboro Fire Department with some of their Balloon Fest activities by providing stand-by coverage with our Ambulance on the 21<sup>st</sup> and with Fire Watch Duty on the Deering side of the Contoocook River during the Fire Works display that same evening. On the 22<sup>nd</sup> we participated in the parade in Hillsboro.
