Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 July to 31 July 2009. The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 17 calls during the month.

Engine Three and Ambulance One both required repairs. Engine Three's battery charger was replaced and the ambulance had work done to the breaks. Both maintenance issues were taken care of by the Highway Department mechanic.

Firefighter Jerry Tramontozzi has been granted a thirty day Medical Leave of Absence beginning July 1st.

Our EMS providers received an overview of the CPAP device from Lieutenant Gidley prior to placing it in service on July 7th. Other training activities were limited due to the weather and vacations – however we did work to prepare a building in West Deering for training later this month. The building was donated to us by the McAlister family.

Our apparatus traveled to parades in Stoddard and Hillsboro with our ambulance winning a trophy for Best Equipped. At the Hillsboro Muster on July 12th, our team (with just four members) won trophies in all events and captured the Overall Trophy as well. The following weekend we were less successful in Greenfield, but still came home with two trophies.

Tony Manning, a Firefighter/Paramedic with the Concord Fire Department, was the winner of the 42" HDTV raffle to support the Deering Fire and Rescue Association. Our thanks to everyone who sold and purchased tickets to support our fundraising efforts; more events are planned for the future.
