Subject: Monthly Report

This month's report will cover the period from 1 September to 30 September 2010.  
The Deering Fire and Rescue responded to 17 calls during the month.

All apparatus have completed State Inspection by the Town Highway Mechanic. Engine Two required new brakes. Boat One went out of service on the 5<sup>th</sup> for repairs to the plug and to fix a small tear in the bottom of the hull. All apparatus is presently in service.

The outside stairs leading to the second floor day room of the Donovan Station have been removed and will be replaced as soon as possible.

Three candidates interviewed with the Department during the September. At this time one new member has been sworn in. Firefighter Bradley Desmaris has joined and will be responding from the McAlister Station. FF Desmaris had prior experience with the Temple Fire Department.

EMS Training on the 21<sup>st</sup> covered drugs that can be administered by Basic and Intermediate level Emergency Medical Technicians.

We practiced MVA Extrication for Fire Training on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. Our Holmatro Cutter blades suffered damage during the drill, requiring repairs. The tool was out of service for approximately one week.

The DLIA meeting was held on September 4<sup>th</sup> at the Town Hall. Assistant Chief Ladue and I attended the meeting and answered a few questions regarding the Training Burn that was held on Lake Shore Drive in August. Although we had the best of intentions, when we went to deploy Boat One for the annual Lake Parade and found that it was not holding water, we were unable to attend this year.

On September 11<sup>th</sup>, we replaced the United States and State of New Hampshire flags and observed a moment of silence at 0846 in the center of town. I was joined by Firefighters Rhett Darner, Don Deschenes, Tony Mayfield, and Pat Murdough.

After the observance, we traveled to each of our stations and put up the new US flags that we had received courtesy of Selectmen Michelle Johnson. We would like to thank Michelle for taking the time out of her schedule to get the flags for us.
