

MONTHLY REPORT**April 2013****NEWS:**

1. Internships: We continue to sponsor two High School Interns.
2. Ofc. Migdal continues to be out on short term disability due to off duty injury.
3. Hillsboro Ford Fleet Sales Rep says the new SUV Cruiser delivery is estimated for week of June 10th.

TRAINING:

1. The PD held "Part 1" of the required 4 hour Annual Use-Of-Force Classroom training.
2. We had to cancel/postpone "Part 2" of this training because Chief Pushee had a DUI (drugged driver) arrest just prior to when the training was scheduled. We have thus scheduled to try to have 2 training sessions in May.
3. Capt. Cavanaugh went to a class at the Hillsboro Police Dept. on identifying and responding to Meth Labs as sponsored by the NH State Forensic Lab.
4. Chief Pushee has created a "roll call" training memo for all officers to read through while on duty regarding police interactions with so-called Sovereign Citizens and other similar or related Anti-Government/Anti-Police persons. This is based on Manchester PD roll-call training memo's.

GRANTS:

1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE: This grant program is being worked. Special Traffic Safety Patrols during Morning and Afternoon Commute hours. Chief Pushee has been submitting quarterly reports and reimbursement soon.
 - b. SPEED Patrol Grant: This grant is being worked. It consists of 30 – three hour patrols specifically targeting speeding vehicles on primary roadways. Chief Pushee will be submitting monthly reports and quarterly reimbursement requests at the appropriate times.
 - c. DWI Patrol Grant: This grant is being worked. It consists of 18 – five hour patrols specifically directed at locating drugged and drunk drivers on our roadways. Chief Pushee will be submitting monthly reports and quarterly reimbursement requests at the appropriate times.
 - d. VIDEO Grant: This grant was approved and our Digital Ally Video unit was ordered and has been received. It will be mounted in the new cruiser when that is upfitted. Reimbursement will be requested AFTER we pay the bill and receive a copy of the cancelled check back from the bank.
2. Portable Radio Grant #2 – The newest portable radio has been sent out for programming, and we should get it back soon.
3. Fish & Game Agency- OHRV Enforcement Grant: We are still awaiting word on whether or not this grant has been approved.

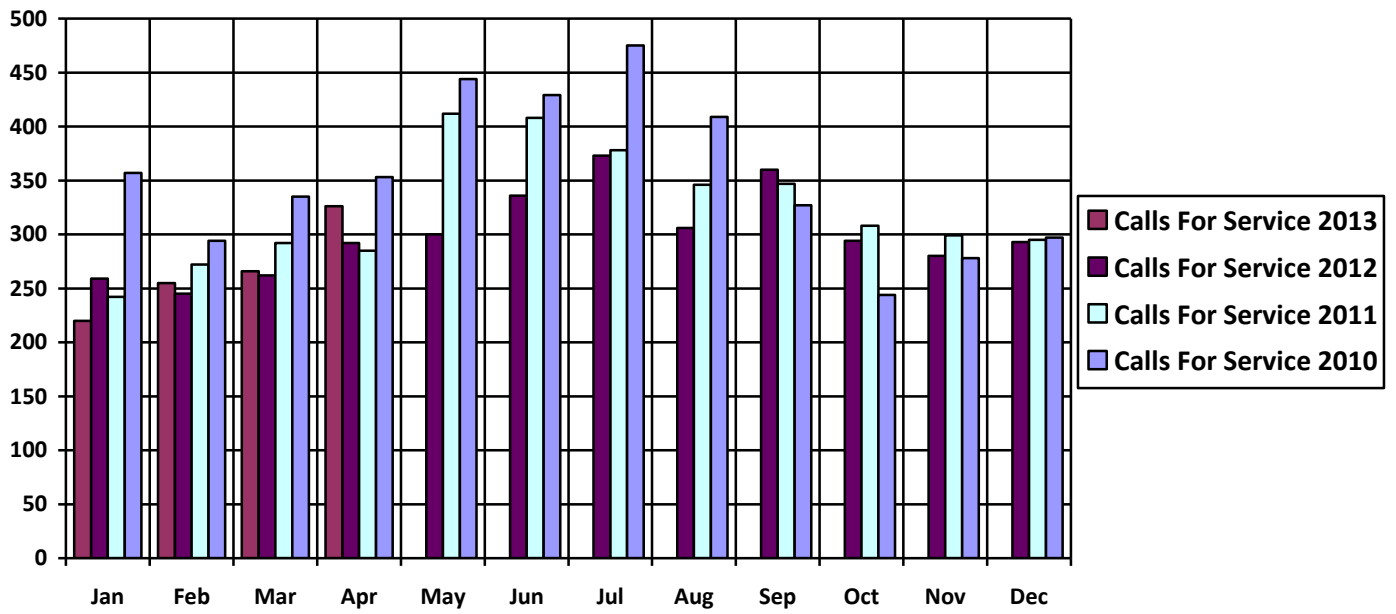
