

MONTHLY REPORT**JUNE 2013****NEWS:**

1. We have been receiving resumes/applications for anticipated openings, full and part time.
2. 2010 Impala has been restriped with the new design.
3. New SUV Cruiser- Purchase order signed for Imperial Fleet Products, letter sent to Hillsborough Ford stating we would not be purchasing through them as previously discussed.
4. We had a SERIOUS MV Crash on Longwoods Road, due to excessive speed and other factors.

TRAINING:

1. PD conducted handgun qualifications for most members. We tried to do Rifle Quals too, but ran out of daylight after some functioning issues.
2. PD sponsored a 2 day "Interactice Use-of-Force" (Simunitions) training put on by Local Govt. Center, at the Airport in the Alt. School facility. Attending were officers from Deering, Antrim, Bennington, Hillsborough, Henniker, Washington, and Warren.
3. Chief Pushee attended 2 training sessions during the NH Chief's of Police Annual Meeting and Trade-Show. One training on "Breaching/Entry during active shooter events" and another on "Dealing with Anti-Police Protests and Personal Interactions."

GRANTS:

1. Highway Safety Agency Grants:
 - a. OPERATION SAFE COMMUTE: This grant program is being worked. Special Traffic Safety Patrols during Morning and Afternoon Commute hours. Chief Pushee has been submitting quarterly reports and reimbursement as they come due.
 - b. SPEED Patrol Grant: This grant is being worked. It consists of 30 – three hour patrols specifically targeting speeding vehicles on primary roadways. Chief Pushee will be submitting monthly reports and quarterly reimbursement requests at the appropriate times.
 - c. DWI Patrol Grant: This grant is being worked. It consists of 18 – five hour patrols specifically directed at locating drugged and drunk drivers on our roadways. Chief Pushee will be submitting monthly reports and quarterly reimbursement requests at the appropriate times.
 - d. VIDEO Grant: The invoice has been submitted for payment. Once we have the cancelled check I can submit for reimbursement
 - We will need to wait for new federal grant budget (October) to apply for funding for 2nd Video Unit as previously discsd.
2. Fish & Game Agency- OHRV Enforcement Grant: We just received notification that we were NOT approved for this grant. Due to budget cuts, this program was dramatically slashed. Only 15 of 36 applications were funded at all, with the largest grant approved being less than \$2500 total.

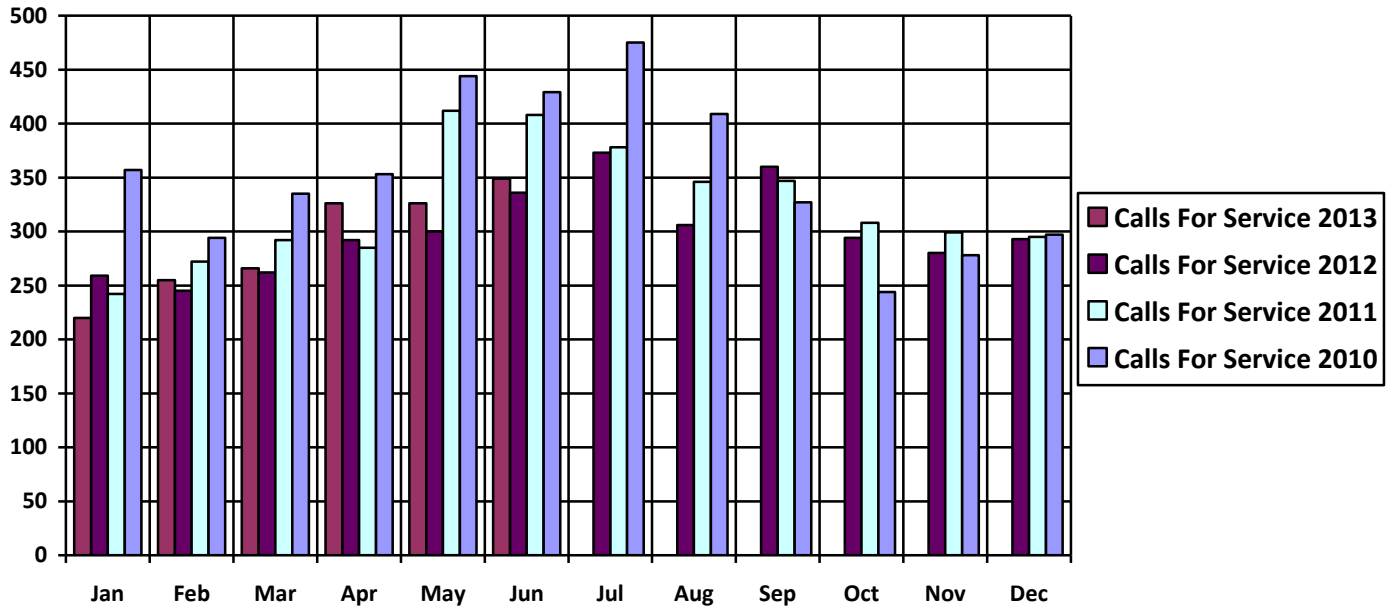
