

MONTHLY REPORT**SEPTEMBER 2010****NEWS:**

1. We have started the search process to fill the open Full Time Officer position.

1. Officer Hargreaves attended OHRV Operators Course.
2. Captain Cavanaugh attended mandatory recertification as a Firearms Instructor (handgun).
3. Chief Pushee attended a grant sponsored training event at the Local Government Center on Employee Discipline Actions.
4. Officer Hargreaves completed an on-line training program for Exploring Advisors. Chief Pushee and Ofc. Censabella will also be going through this on-line training in near future.
5. Chief Pushee attended an grant based training sponsored by the IACP in Vermont, on Criminal Investigations During MV Enforcement Patrols.

GRANTS:

1. OHRV Enforcement Grant: I spoke to a secretary at NH Fish & Game about why this grant hasn't been received yet. Apparently she didn't submit the Application for approval because it bore the Town Administrator's Approval, but was not a voted approval by the Board of Selectman. This is a grant to provide wheeled OHRV based patrols on the State Trail system. We've used this in the past to enforce and educate riders on OHRV Safety Regulations.
2. Primex P3 Workers Compensation Safety Initiative Grant Program: I've been bogged down and haven't had the chance to work further on my "gym mats" ideas for this grant program yet, but still intend to when I find a way to slow the passage of time!
