- c) matters which, if discussed in public, would likely affect adversely the reputation of any person, other than a member of the publicbody itself, unless such person requests an open meeting;
- d) consideration of the acquisition, sale or lease of property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community; and
- consideration or negotiations of pending claims or litigation which has been threatened in writing or filed against the body or agencyor any; subdivision thereof, or against any member thereof, because of his/her membership in such body or agency until the claim or litigation has been fully adjudicated or otherwise settled.
- k) Consideration by a school board of entering into a student or pupil tuition contract authorized by RSA 194 or RSA 195-A, which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general public or the school district that is considering a contract, including any meeting between the school boards, or committees thereof, involved in the negotiations.
- Consideration of legal advice provided by legal counsel, either in writing or orally, to one or more members of the public body, even where legal counsel is not present.
- m) Consideration of whether to disclose minutes of a nonpublic session due to a change in circumstances under paragraph III. However, any vote on whether to disclose minutes shall take place in public session.
