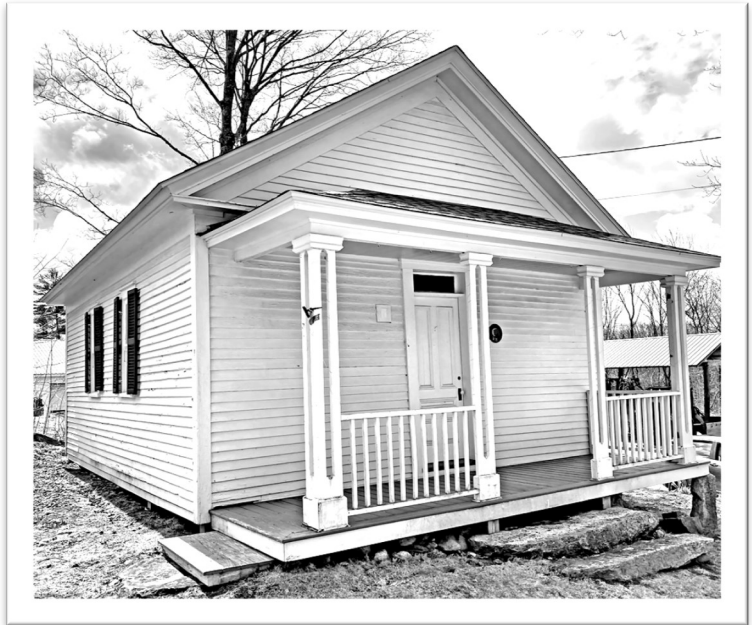


YOU ARE INVITED TO BE A PART OF DEERING HISTORY!

In anticipation of Deering's 250th anniversary, the Library Trustees are offering the purchase of commemorative bricks to be placed in the walkway from the Town Hall parking lot to the one-room schoolhouse. Our District 1 Schoolhouse/Deering Public Library was the first building in Deering to be listed on the New Hampshire Register of Historic Places, and much work is being done to make it safe and comfortable to reopen.
