Private wells users should have their water tested every 3 to 5 years.

There will be a short presentation by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services to review proper sampling techniques, commonly occurring contaminants, treatment methods, and a Q&A session.

Many wells in NH have naturally-occurring contaminants. The most common of these contaminants—radon and arsenic—increase the risk of cancer and other diseases. Some of these contaminants have no taste, odor, or color. In Deering (2006-2020), 100 private wells were tested for Arsenic—29% exceeded the health limit. Of 25 wells tested for Radon, 8% exceeded the health limit. 27% of 92 wells tested for sodium exceeded the health limit.
